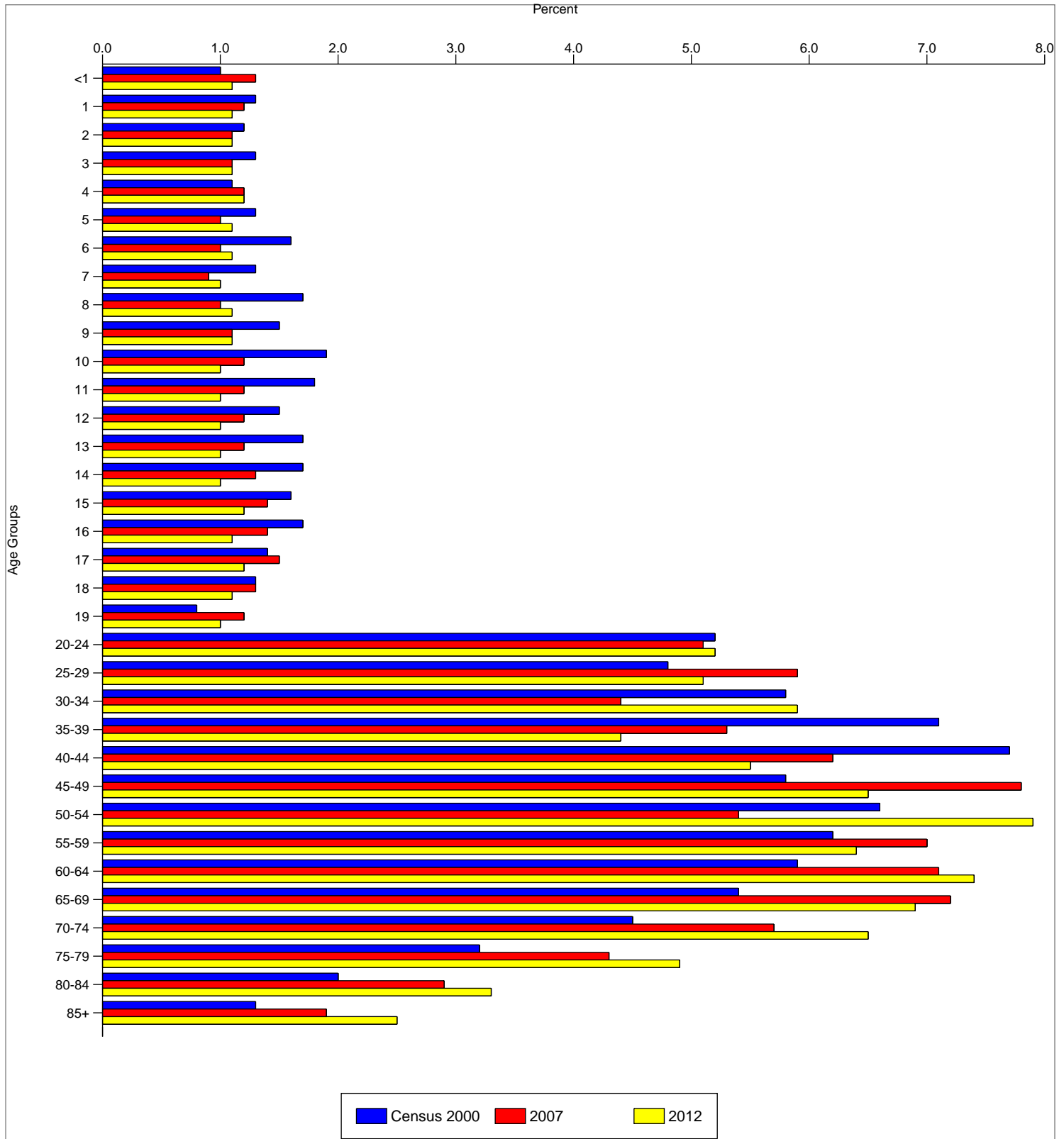

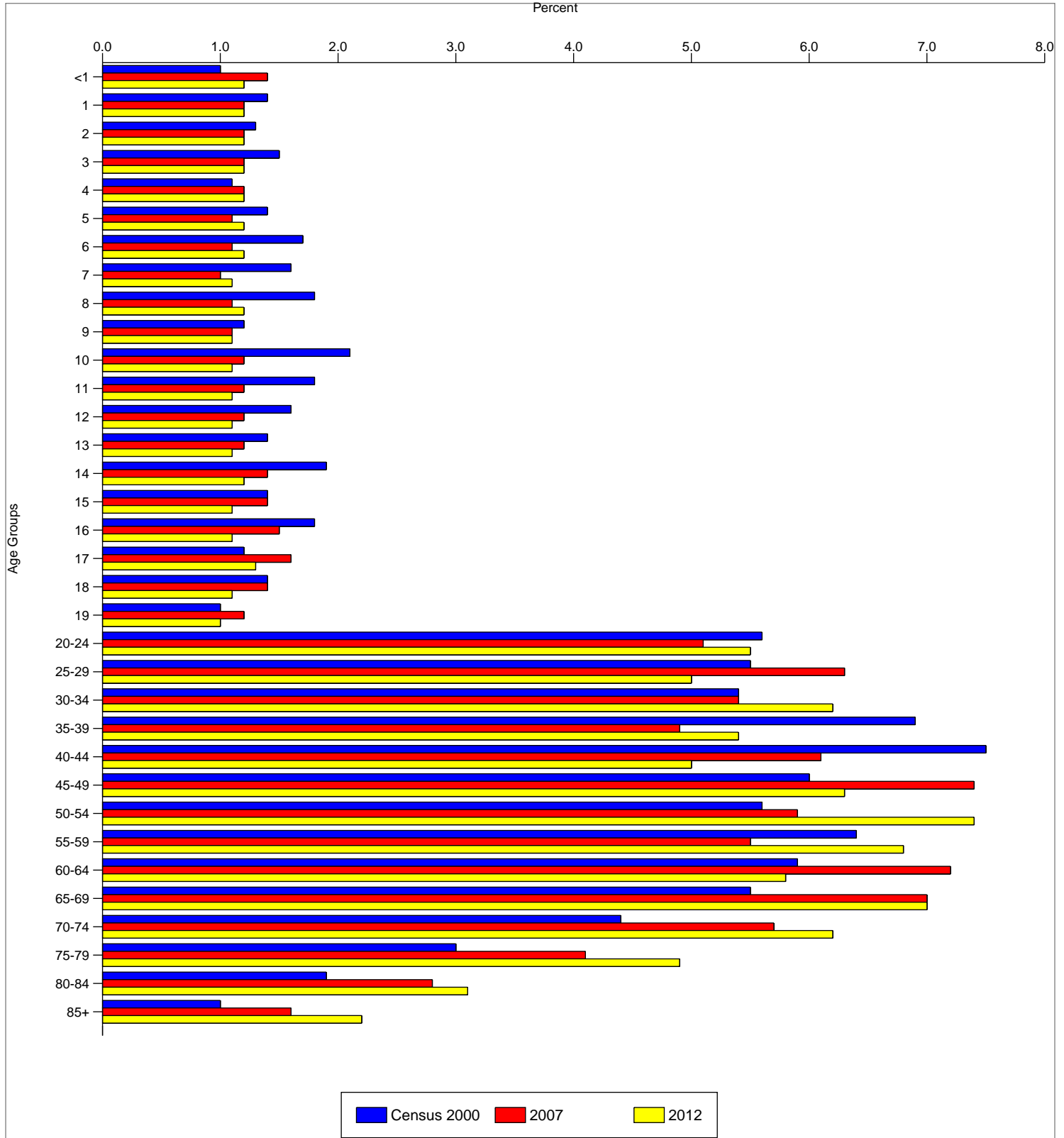

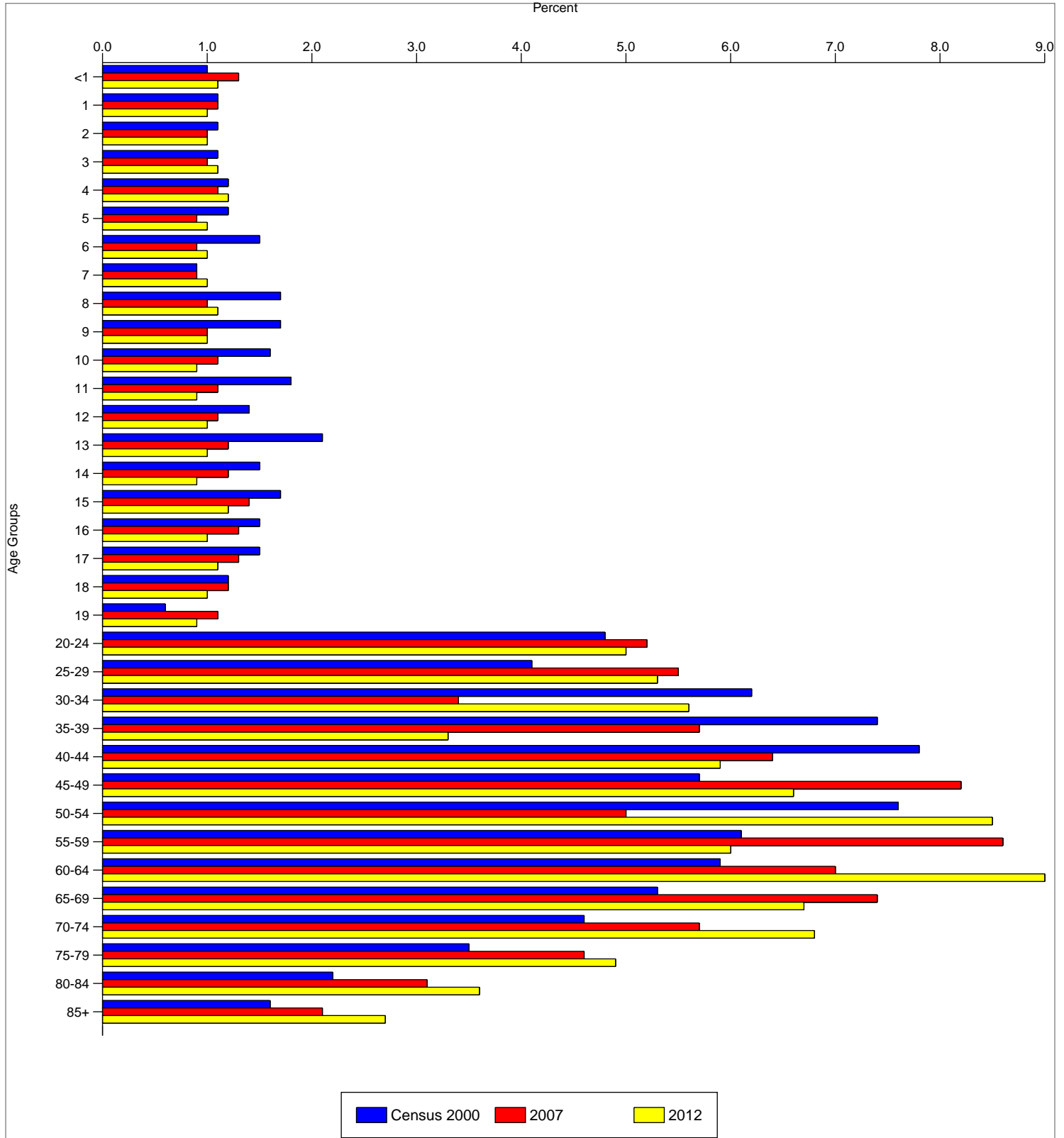

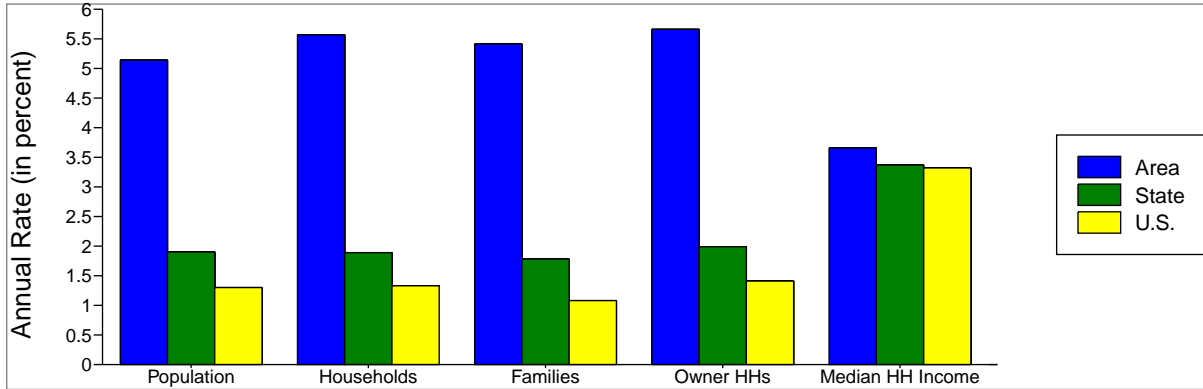

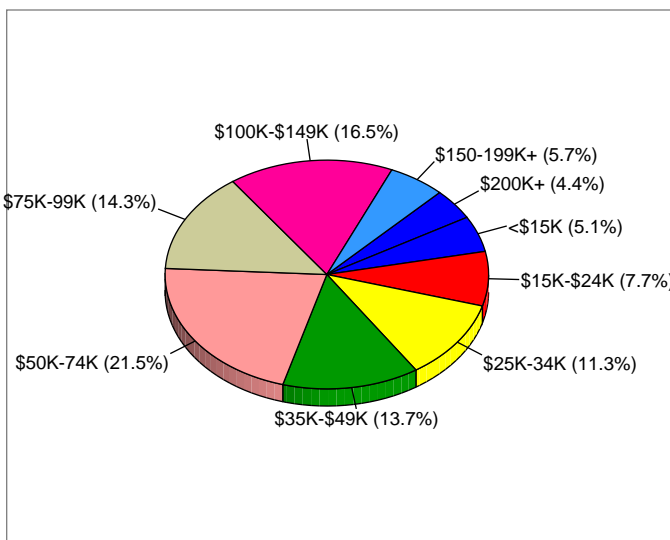
Trends 2007-2012



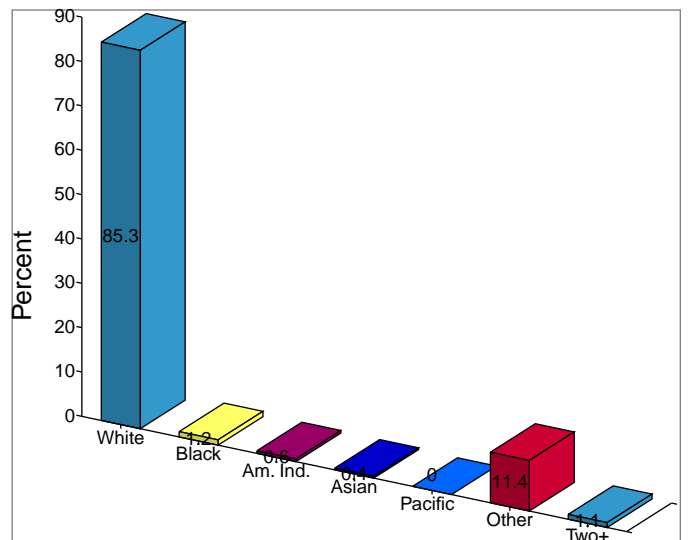
Population by Age
